

EDT2 Item Settings Guide

Item Details Tab

The Item Details tab can be accessed via the Job Settings found in the ECon Configuration menu. It allows users to configure the way items are uploaded through Econ via the following settings:

Upload Items

Checking this box will allow EDT2 to upload items to the website when they are added or updated in the Edge.

Upload All Items

If checked, EDT2 will upload all valid items to the website during the next upload. Once the full upload is complete, Upload All Items will be automatically unchecked unless the Every Time box is also checked.*

Item Options Drop-Downs	Three drop-down menus determining which Item Statuses, Pricing Methods, and Inventory Types will be included in uploads. Items must have all three fields matching the selected settings to be uploaded.
Exclusion Drop-Downs	Three drop-down menus allowing users to exclude specific item categories, vendors, and stores from being included in uploads.
Exclude Items with No Photo	If checked, items with no photo attached to their Edge record will not be included in uploads.
Exclude Items with no Appraisal Long Description	If checked, items with no Appraisal Long Description will not be included in uploads.
Exclude all Images	If checked, prevents any image files from exporting from the Edge.
Ignore Always and Never Upload Flags	If checked, EDT2 will ignore the “Always Upload This Item” and “Never Upload This Item” options on an item’s Website tab when determining whether to include that item in an upload.
Upload up to X Photos per Item	Determines the maximum number of photos that can be uploaded per item.
Upload non-photo files	If checked, non-photo files, such as PDFs, can be uploaded with an item’s images.
Shrink Images	If an image’s file size is greater than the given amount in the first field, the image’s longest side will be reduced to the number of pixels given in the second field. Putting 0 in either field will result in no resizing.
Description Length Limit	Limits the length of uploaded web descriptions to the given number of characters. If set to zero, the length will not be limited.
Convert line breaks to
	If checked, any line breaks in an item's web description will be converted to HTML tags.
Substitute Appraisal Long Description if available	If checked, substitutes general item description for the pre-appraisal long description, if applicable.

Send Long Item Detail Values

If checked, EDT2 will send the long values for an item's Item Detail fields instead of the short values. For example, instead of sending Metal Type values of "14" or "PL", EDT2 will send "14 Karat" or "Platinum".

*Note: The "Every Time" option is typically only used for web developers who specifically request a full upload every time EDT2 runs.

Website Tab

An item's website information can be edited in the Website tab of the item's Edge record. Any changes made in the Website tab will be reflected in the item's product entry in Shopify. See [here](#) for more information on the Website tab.
