
Econ Item Settings Guide

Item Details Tab

The Item Details tab can be accessed via the Job Settings found in the ECon Configuration menu. It allows users to configure the way items are uploaded through Econ via the following settings:



- 1. Upload Inventory when it changes
- Checking this box will allow Econ to upload items to Shopify when they are added or updated in the Edge.
- 2. Load Web Details from Web Changes

If checked, updating an item's details on Shopify (e.g. title, description, etc.) will cause the relevant fields to update on the Website tab of the item's Edge record.*


3. Exclusion Drop- down Menus	Three drop-down menus allowing users to exclude specific item categories, vendors, and stores from being included in uploads.	
4. Selected Pricing Methods	Check boxes determining which pricing methods will be included in uploads. If a pricing method is not checked, items using that method will not be uploaded. Two pricing methods are currently supported: Individual item pricing and UPC/SKU pricing.	
5. Exclude Items with No Photo	If checked, items with no photo attached to their Edge record will not be included in uploads.	
6. Exclude Items with empty Website Tab	If checked, items with no information entered into the Website tab of their Edge record will not be included in uploads.	
7. Image Settings	Upload up to X Photos per item	Determines the maximum number of photos that can be uploaded per item.
	Image Width X pixels	If an image's width is greater than the given number of pixels, it will be shrunk down to that amount. If the given number is zero, images will not be resized.
	Overwrite Images on Update	If checked, uploading an item will cause that item's images on the site to be replaced with images attached to the item's Edge record.**
	Exclude all images	If checked, prevents any image files from exporting from the Edge.
8. Vendor Style Category Details***	Vendor Style Category Details: Determines where the details come from for items managed by Vendor/Style. Users can choose between details coming from the last entered In Stock item, or from the last entered item regardless of status.	
9. Convert line breaks to 	If checked, any line breaks in an item's web description will be converted to HTML tags.	
10. Exclude Meta Title/Description Updates	If checked, any updates made to an item's meta title or meta description will not be included in uploads to Shopify.	

11. Selected Inventory Types	Determines which item inventory types will be included in the uploads.
12. Selected Inventory Statuses	Determines which item inventory statuses will be included in the uploads. Currently, only In Stock items may be uploaded.
13. Description Length Limit	Limits the length of uploaded web descriptions to the given number of characters. If set to zero, the length will not be limited.
14. When web title is missing	Determines what an item's web title will default to in the absence of a custom web title. Users can choose between the item's Category Name, Category Description, or Item Description.

^{*}Currently, the Meta Keywords field does not map to Shopify.

Website Tab

An item's website information can be edited in the Website tab of the item's Edge record. Any changes made in the Website tab will be reflected in the item's product entry in Shopify.



^{**}If photos are being managed site-side, it is recommended to uncheck this setting.
