

Using the Photo Box

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Positioning the Photo Box

- Lighting is key to professional-looking pictures. Ensure the photo box is positioned so enough light gets to it but without creating shadows. If not, ensure there is enough light to get a good picture.
- Position the photo box so that the camera hole opening is facing up.
- Position the photo box so that the opening is towards you. This will allow you to adjust the platform and object.
- Make sure the camera can reach the photo box.

Setting Up the Photo Box

- 1. The photo box comes with two platforms and there are five different positions for the platforms.
- 2. Select a platform and position it to your preference.
- 3. Select a holder if you are using one. Place your object into the holder and position it to your preference.



- 4. Provide a light source so the picture is well lit.
- 5. Once you are satisfied with the position of the object and the lighting, go ahead and take your picture using The Edge's Photo function or Acquire function.
